Made in a supple spicy Syrah style. This juicy and effortlessly-delicious wine has the Perrin family fingerprints all over it and the grapes have been grown organically. (C) 13% vol

We are proud to support two local Cornish wineries - Camel Valley near Bodmin and Knightor near St Austell. Due to our often challenging climate, English wines are mostly white or sparkling. The grape varieties used tend to be the ones suited to our climate such as Bacchus and Madeleine Angevine. The style is light and fruity and the wines are well suited to the wonderful shellfish and seafood on our menu.
